Pound Cake Recipe by Annette Sexton

- 1 # butter (or 1/2 Imperial and 1/2 butter)
- 1 # confectioners' sugar (whole box)
- 6 eggs (add to ingredients one at a time, beat well after each addition)
- 3 Cups cake flour (add a little at a time, beat well after each addition)
- 1½ teas. vanilla (add & beat well)

Makes enough for one large tube cake pan or 2 loaf pans. Bake @ 350 degrees for at least 1 hour and 10 min. for tube pan or less for 2 loaf pans. Test for doneness.

This cake recipe was handed down from my mother and she, my sister, and I have made it at Christmas time for many years. It's not difficult to make and it is delicious.
