COMPOSTING

The most amazing thing to me about plants is their resiliency. I have some old trash cans in my back yard that the City of Phoenix converts and sells for composting (only \$5.00). I got them from 35TH AVENUE LANDFIL. It's a great way to start composting, so save your plants and vegetables trimming and start to COMPOST.

TIME TO PLANT:

Asparagus, Bush Beans, Pole Beans, Beets, Broccoli, Brussel Sprouts, Cabbage, Carrots, Cauliflower, Swiss Chard, Chinese Cabbage, Collard, Endive, Garlic, Kale, Leeks, Leaf Lettuce, Mustard Greens, Onions, Parsley, Peppers, Irish Potatoes, Radish, Rutabaga, Spinach, Tomatoe (seed) and Turnips.
